Heats will be conducted in the Multi-Class format and will be seeded by time. Fixed class finals will be conducted in all events to be swum at the 2020 Tokyo Paralympic Games. A swimmer must place in the top eight (8) in their class during preliminaries to advance to the final. Only three swimmers per country may progress to the final. Competitors in events that are not on the eligible event list for the 2020 Tokyo Paralympic Games can swim during the multi-class preliminary sessions and where accommodated may progress to finals if they swim up one class and qualify in a Paralympic event class.
