Conditions of Entry

1. All registered competitive and club swimmers are eligible to enter.
2. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules.
3. Only Short Course times will be accepted for entry. Converted long course times may be used and times from unapproved meets are allowed.
4. Age as at 15th March, 2025.
5. Entry Fees are: Individual Entry \$10.00. No Regional Pathways Levy is included in this entry fee, rather any profit from this meet will be used to fund and promote the SCWC Regional Pathways Program.
6. Individual entries should be done online and close on Thursday 6th March 2025 at midnight. Any clubs that enter for their swimmers will be invoiced at the conclusion of the meet.
7. There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.
8. SCWC reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline and the Health and Safety requirements at the venue are adhered to.
9. Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions.
10. Late entries will be at the Technical Advisor and/or Referees discretion based on lane space availability. A late entry fee of \$15.00 per event will apply and swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points. These will be swum as exhibition swims only.
11. Draft Psych Sheets, Entry Lists and Timelines will be posted on the SCWC website on Friday 7th March.
12. Please check names, entries and events are correct. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Final psych sheets, Team Entries and Timelines will be posted on the SCWC website on Wednesday 12th March.

MEET RULES

1. General
2. The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's Competition and Event Policies in conjunction with the New Zealand Swimming Rules and World Aquatics regulations, except where local meet rules and Conditions apply. This includes the SCWC Technical Suit Policy for all competitors 12 years of age and under.
3. There are no qualifying times and "No Times" will be accepted.
4. Events will be swum as timed finals and swum mixed gender - seeded slowest to fastest and split into age groups for final placings and medals.
5. Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Advisor and/or Referee.
6. Electronic/semi automatic timing (touch pads &/or button) will be used at this meet with a minimum of 1 timekeeper per lane using 10 lanes (subject to the number of officials).
7. Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
8. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4 accompanied with the \$100.00 fee.
9. Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
10. Please exit the pool at the side. **Do not** swim over the lane ropes.
11. Cameras and Photography
SCWC and/or the host Club may take photos and videos may be taken during the meet: all spectators and athletes agree to allow photos, video and audio recording to be taken by an SCWC approved and/or

accredited person to be used for any legitimate purposes by SCWC and/or the meet organisers. Any concerns should be directed to the meet organisers. Spectators agree upon entry that photographic, video or audio recording equipment is prohibited for any purpose, with the exclusion of personal cell phones. The meet organisers will, at their sole discretion, determine whether or not an item which could be used for the purposes of taking photos, video or audio recordings are permitted for use during the meet. Photos remain copyright of the approved/accredited person.

Scratching / Withdrawals

1. All event scratchings received before 5.00pm on Wednesday 12th March will be refunded. There will be no refunds after this.
2. Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the Clerk of Course (Marshall) at the appropriate time prior to their event and the withdrawal fee will apply.
3. A \$20.00 fine will apply without excuse to all late or non-scratching from events.
4. Refunds may be considered, providing a medical certificate is provided.

Warm Up

1. As per Swimming Canterbury West Coast warm-up procedure guidelines,
2. Warm-up is the responsibility of the clubs, coaches and swimmers involved. Officials are not responsible for managing or controlling the warm-up procedures.
3. 2 lanes of the Recreation pool are available for warm up/warm down from 1.30pm.

Marshalling

1. Marshalling will be at the start end of the racing pool next to the stands.
2. All swimmers must marshal for their events.
3. Swimmers should be in the marshalling area six (6) races prior to their event

Age Groups/Awards

1. All individual events will be resulted in the following age groups: 10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 and 17 & O.
2. There will be no medals or ribbons for this meet.
3. The winner of each age group will be determined by the combined points from the 4 events using the standard points.
4. The winner of each age group will receive a towel.

Programme of events – Timed Finals

1. Mixed 50m Backstroke
2. Mixed 50m Breaststroke
3. Mixed 50m Butterfly
4. Mixed 50m Freestyle

Officials Convenor to advise all those officiating at the meet that they are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees, IOTS & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time. Earlier than the start of warm-up is preferable.

As per the Swimming New Zealand Regulations there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be approved as an Officiated meet and for the times swum to be accepted for national event qualification. The 'Minimum Officials for Officiated Meets' sheet must be completed for each session, signed by the Referee and sent to the region. The region must, within seven (7) days of the completion of the meet forward the meet results and the officials sheet/s to SNZ.
