Event Information

The 2017 State Teams Course Championships will be held at the Australian Institute of Sport, Canberra from Friday 22 to Sunday 24 September 2017. The event is a team based competition, in which state teams go head-to-head in a variety of individual and relay events to score points for their state.

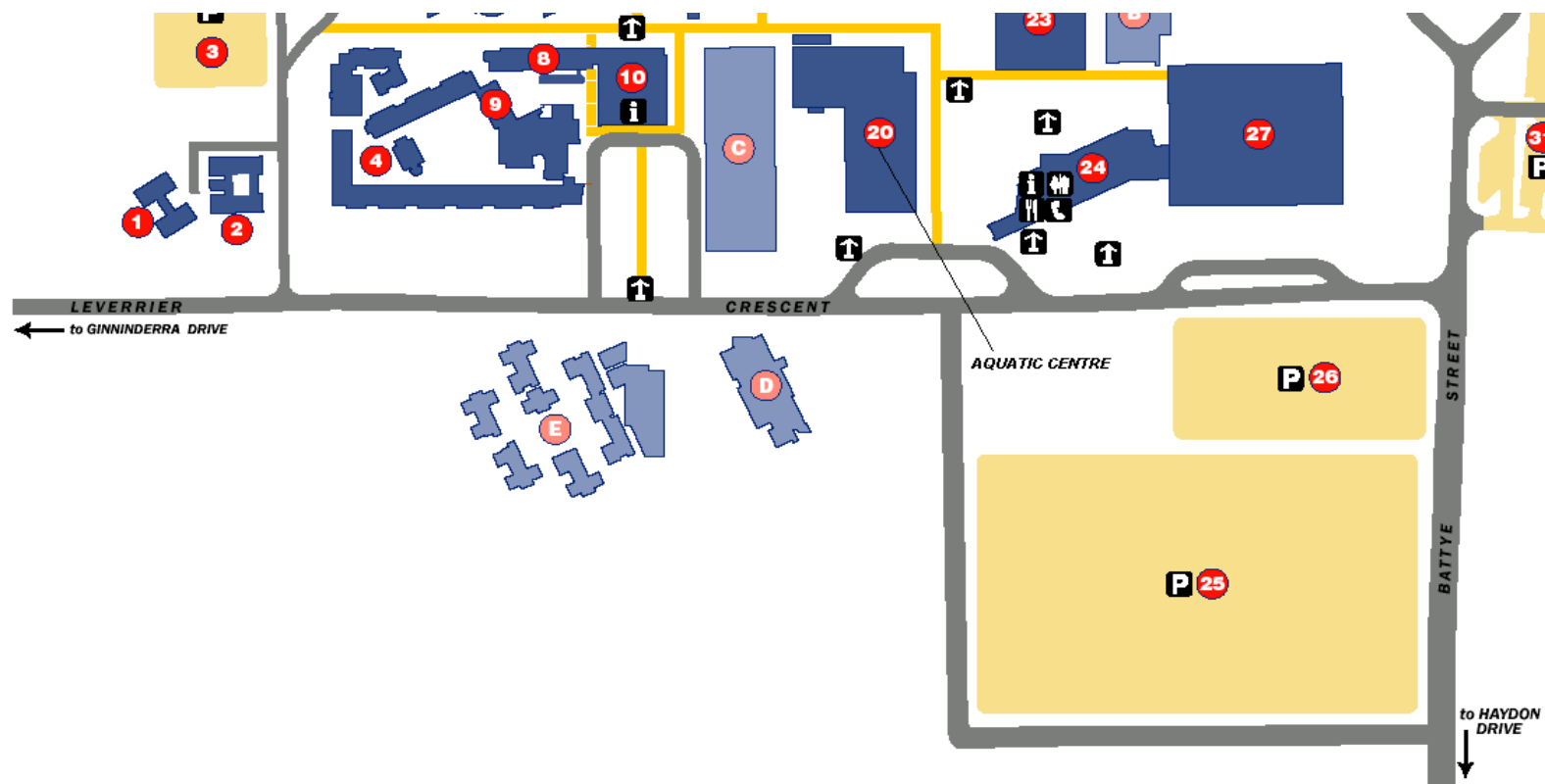
Selection

Each State Association is responsible for selecting, entering, coaching and managing their team. Teams may incorporate a maximum of 40 swimmers, with no more than 10 males and 10 females in each age group. Age groups for males are 14/15 years and 16/17 years, and age groups for females are 13/14 and 15/16. A swimmer's age will be classified by their age as at Friday 22 September 2017.

Parking

If required, parking is available in the AIS car parks, located off Leverrier Cres in Bruce (P25 and P23). Parking is free of charge however the AIS will have several events running concurrently with the 2017 State Teams Age Short Course Championships so it is advised to arrive before the session start time to obtain parking.
